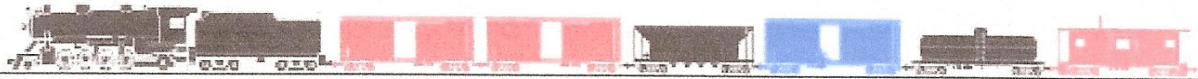

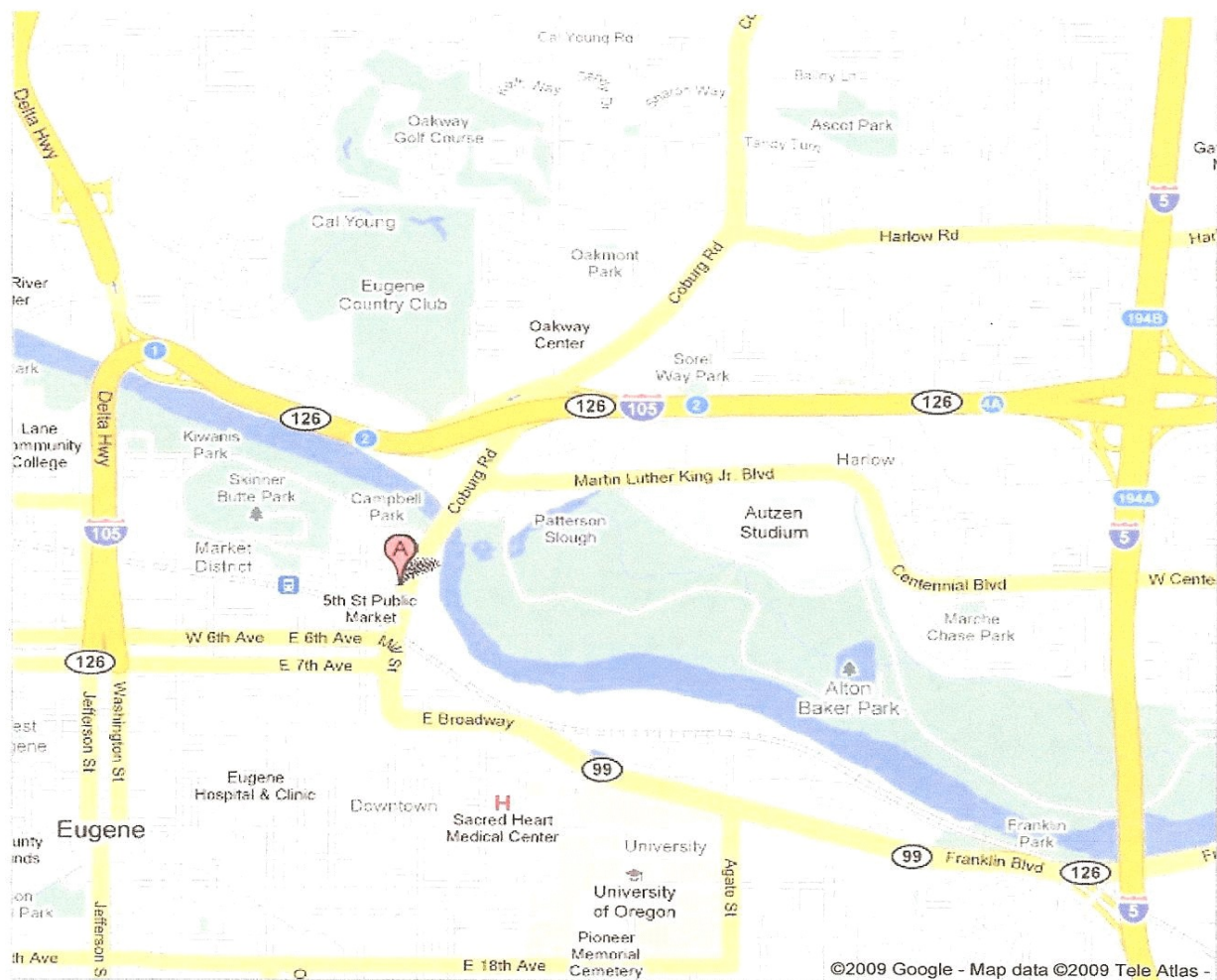


Directions to October 10 Mini-meet Location

Details

From I-5 take exit 194B to I-105 Eugene. Stay in right lane about 1.3 mile,
Take exit 2 Coburg road one tenth mile. Keep left at 'Y' to city center & U of O
Three tenth mile ramp enters Coburg road. Stay in right lane
After crossing river,(180 ft.) turn next right on 3rd ave.
One block turn left on mill st.
One block turn left on 4th ave.
After going under Coburg road turn right in to parking lot.
Meeting will be in the building closest to 4th ave.
There may be congestion in the parking lot as there is a
Sorooptimist walk using the area as a base also.
