PNR 2020 Convention Report

Due to the rise and risk of COVID-19 disease in March, the convention was canceled. While we missed the opportunity to host a great convention and to briefly thaw visitors from more polar latitudes, we are happy that everyone is safe.

Thanks to efforts by Larry and Lori Sebelley, convention registrations were refunded to purchasers in full, including all online fees normally incurred for such transactions. Although we are still awaiting one or two refund checks, First Division minimized the financial loss for holding a canceled convention. We appreciate the support and advice of PNR board members on several matters, including alerting us to the *force majeure* clause in our hotel agreement. We hope the National Convention will be as lucky as we were in that regard. Our final accounting awaits resolution of the items. We are not requesting support from PNR at this time, and will not do so unless the hotel changes its mind and declines to issue a refund for our deposits.

Our order of 30 laser-cut MOW buildings from Motrak Models, for a special model-building clinic as part of the convention, was filled in full and arrived in April. The kits are being stored until we hold the clinic at a future convention.
